

'Multics Release 10' Offered For Honeywell Series 60, Level 68

PHOENIX — Honeywell Information Systems has announced the availability of Multics Release 10 (MR10) of its Multics operating system software.

Now available for existing, newly ordered, or additional Multics central systems of the Honeywell Series 60, Level 68 and DPS 8/M hardware product lines, MR10 now offers the capability to reduce system recovery time and support for high-speed communications circuits, the vendor said. Magnetic tape processing has reportedly been improved in several areas, including support of larger tape records.

There is no charge for the new release of Multics for its current users,

the vendor noted.

Honeywell is releasing two additional products along with MR10. The Inter Multics File Transfer Facility provides for queued transfer of individual files or directories between Multics systems. The Network Interface Facility connects Multics systems to X.25 networks, such as Tymnet, Inc.'s Tymnet. Monthly license fees for these products are \$43 for the Inter Multics File Transfer Facility and \$150 for the Network Interface Facility.
